Which Tier?

How to determine your child's tier?

Tier 1

- ✓ Is your child developing speech & language skills as expected?
- ✓ Is your child playing with other children as expected?
- ✓ Does your child follow directions without physical prompting?
- ✓ Does your child separate from you to go to friends or family?

Tier 2

- ✓ Is your child diagnosed with mild ASD?
- ✓ Is your child experiencing speech or mild behavioral challenges?
- ✓ Can your child sit and engage in classroom activities minimal one-on-one adult support?
- ✓ Is your child enrolled in private therapy sessions?
- ✓ Is your child experiencing learning challenges?

Tier 3

- ✓ Is your child diagnosed with mild to moderate ASD?
- ✓ Is your child experiencing a speech or language delay?
- ✓ Does your child require adult support to function?
- ✓ Does your child require specialist support in the classroom?
- ✓ Is your child experiencing moderate / severe behavioral challenges?
- ✓ Is your child enrolled in private therapy sessions?

Why are fees tiered?



DaySpring is committed to inclusion. We make an effort to include students of various developmental, academic and behavioral levels in the school. All students require different levels of educational support, behavioral support, accommodations, supervision and intervention. Fees are tiered based on those needs.

- ✓ **Educational / Academic support** – Academic goals based on deficiencies or enrichment needs are made for specified children.
- ✓ **Behavioral support** – Students who require additional behavioral interventions are able to receive it from the therapist sent by Seahorse institute
- ✓ **Accommodations** – Included in the Personal Training Strategy are accommodations which need to be made in the classroom to help the child to be included in the mainstream classroom
- ✓ **Intervention** – Students whose parents have arranged for them to receive therapy while in school are able to receive it from the therapist of the parent's choice (at the parent's expense) in one of our classrooms. .

Tier 1 Fee Mainstream Classroom

The children in these classrooms are able to function without special accommodations. This classroom is also referred to as general education.

Tier 3 Fee

Special Education Support (SPED)

The children in tier 3 demand a level of support, therapy and intervention that requires staff with training in special education .

What Should Parents Expect

- ✓ Targeted verbal / behavior support for a neuro-divergent learner
- ✓ Pull-out, individualized, learning support activities
- ✓ Play based therapeutic activities for strengthening social skills
- ✓ Play based therapeutic activities for strengthening motor skills
- ✓ Weekly sessions with Registered Behavior Technician (RBT)
- ✓ Personal Training Strategy (PTS / IEP)

Parents are given a grace period of 30 minutes to collect children from school.

After school care begins at 3:30

Weekly rate:

3:30pm to 4:00pm \$25 per week

3:30pm to 5:00pm \$40 per week

Late pick up penalty:

for students who are picked up late but not a part of the after school care program

3:30 - 3:45pm - \$10/day

3:46 - 4:00pm - \$15/day

4:01 - 5:00pm - \$20/day

After 5:01pm - \$1 per minute
